Semesters 2025...2026

Children develop a new, stronger awareness of themselves at the age of nine and ten.

The oral work is continued, including speech exercises, verses, poems, songs, and question-and-answer games, but everything that the class has learned as a group becomes more individualized. Writing in English is introduced, and it becomes the main theme of the year.

Goals By the end of the fifth grade,
the children

should know the following:

- the English alphabet
- how to spell their own names and several commonly used words
- how to read words and sentences they have practiced practised
- how to give simple descriptions
- the verb forms in the present tense
- the classes of words (noun, verb and adjective)
- how to write simple sentences by themselves

Fall semester 2025

Possible Lesson Content

- *Singing and reciting poems and verses
- *Games that encourage children to practice speaking
- *The alphabet is practiced, as are spelling

- * Writing is introduced using texts of poems and verses that the children have learned in previous years.
- *Use of the words in speaking and writing simple stories that the children already know,
- *Short texts writing work, e.g., about animals or the weather, and household objects.

Winter semester 2025...2026

- *Vocabulary words, after having been thoroughly practised orally, are written down in lists of words-families (e.g., parts of the body, the classroom, seasons, colors). These lists are only in the English language.
- * Telling or reading short stories.
- *Then copying the story from the board.
(In this way reading continues to be practiced through writing.)
- *Using the words in simple stories that the children already know.
Then the children copy two or three sentences, which express the main content of the story from the board. The text includes as much repetition as possible.
- *The children learn and recite new poems about nature, the seasons, and topics connected with the main lesson blocks.

Spring 2026

Possible Lesson Content

- *Introduction to Grammar, Noun, verb and adjective.
- For the beginning of grammar work, the children are first exposed to the following forms:
the present tense of common verbs in

combination with personal pronouns (other tenses may appear in the context of a text), classes of words, plurals, common adjective, prepositions. (Nouns are used orally in complete sentences, with the appropriate verb forms and simple adjectives.)

*Discussions about English grammar are held in the children's native language.

*Spelling and short dictation practice,

* Work with question words is continued;

* questions with "to do" are practiced in writing.

*Games and plays, little dramatic scenes, guessing games and similar activities continue to be an important part of the lessons.
